Program Descriptions:

Circle Time: Join us with your children (newborn-6 yrs.) and take pleasure in songs, rhymes and stories. Join from the comfort of your home.

Building Connections: an opportunity to connect live on zoom with a staff member to ask questions, interact and/or engage with other families

Preschool Learning with Nature: Weekly program for families with preschool children (2.5-5 yrs.) to explore learning in a fun way using nature

Family Corner: a safe, respectful virtual space to discuss thoughts, feelings and resources about a variety of topics around parenting and caring for kids.

Nurturing Development: a virtual program for families impacted by a variety of visible and invisible disabilities, medical conditions or unique learning styles with children 0 to 6 years old. Come meet with other families. A Child and Family Resource Consultant is available to provide strategies, resources and referrals for families' individual needs.

Agnes and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ): book a virtual appointment from the comfort of your home with an RECE Child and Family Resource Consultant to complete the questionnaire and talk about learning through play strategies to support your child's overall development.

Seed & Sprout: a monthly virtual 2SLGBTQIA Family Building Space.
